I am a professional, classically-trained singer, performing with many of the UK's leading choirs, orchestras and opera companies. Recent highlights include singing as a soloist with the London Symphony Orchestra at the Barbican and with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra at Cadogan Hall, performing around the country with Opera North, Opera Holland Park and Buxton International Festival, and giving a lunchtime recital at the Royal Opera House.

For over ten years, I've been singing at funerals and memorial services of all kinds - at crematoriums and gravesides, from the tiniest of churches to Salford Cathedral. Frequently asked questions...

Can you learn a special song?

Yes. I'm very happy to learn new songs. I already have a wide repertoire, so if it's a classical piece, I might already know it! But if not, I am a quick learner. There may be a small extra charge if I need to get hold of special piano part or arrangement. I'm always happy to discuss, so do get in touch and ask.

I'd like a duet or a choir...

As well as singing as a soloist, I can also arrange other singers, from a duet to a full choir. My colleagues are all highly accomplished, classically-trained singers - graduates of top music colleges, who sing with orchestras, choirs and opera companies around the UK.

Do you perform with backing track?

No. I always sing live (no backing tracks or microphone). I usually sing with an organist or pianist, but I also have a selection of unaccompanied songs.

Can you arrange a pianist or organist?

Yes - I can organise for a talented pianist or organist to come with me to play (this will involve an extra cost). Alternatively, I am happy to work with the resident organist of a church. I will arrange a short rehearsal with them before the service on the day.

Can you sing outdoors?

Yes. I have a selection of beautiful unaccompanied songs that work outdoors – a solo voice can provide a beautifully atmospheric moment.

What will you wear?

I usually wear smart, black clothes - but am happy to wear something different.
